# CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

The Town of Carnduff has a number of projects currently on the go and we wish to update our residents on them!

#### **Lagoon Project**

The installation of the new force main is near completion. We are in the process of completing some geotechnical work which is required for a permit from CP Rail in order to place the force main under the rail line. This is the only remaining portion of the force main left to complete.

The two new pumping stations are near completion and will be brought online once the force main is complete.

The pilot project for the new bio filters at the water plant is complete. We are currently working to finish the design for the installation of the bio-filter system in the building.

This project has been budgeted at \$8.52 million. Under the NBCF (New Building Canada Fund) this project has been funded by 1/3 of each the Town, Province of Saskatchewan and Federal Government.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Water Main Installation

The Town has received approval under the Federal Gas Tax Fund to complete the addition of a second water main from Spencer Street under Highway 18, connecting at 3<sup>rd</sup> Street West. This will provide for a second main line to feed the main portion of the community.

There is geotechnical work being completed in order to apply to CP Rail for a permit to construct under the rail line. Permits from Department of Highways will also need to be applied for.

# **REC REPORT**
