If the meter is damaged, it is the property owners responsibility to cover the cost of replacing that meter. If you are shutting the heat off at your property, it is important to let the Town know this so we can properly address the meter. Even when a person winterizes their water lines, there is still water left in the water meter that can freeze and break the meter.


