### ANIMAL CONTROL

There has been ongoing discussion with Animal Control



within the Town of Carnduff. Council is currently undergoing a review of the Animal Control Bylaw #472-15 to ensure it meets the needs of the community. We will keep the community apprised to any changes.

The Town is currently looking for an Animal Control Officer whom will be responsible for the enforcement of the bylaw. As a citizen, if you witness a contravention of the bylaw, you are asked to report it in writing to the Town Office. If the complaint contains enough information to support a bylaw violation, the owner will be served a violation.





Complaints must be written and include a date and

time of the incident, a summary of what happened, animal owners name if known, and a signature of the person submitting the complaint. If you are able to submit supporting proof, that is always useful. This information is required in the event the violation is taken to court.

It is important to know the Town does not have the authority to deem a dog dangerous. This must be done by the courts.

If your concern is regarding the health



and welfare of an animal, your concern can be reported to Animal Protection Services by calling 1-844-382-0002.

#### ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER

The Town of Carnduff is currently accepting applications for a contract Animal Control Officer. This is a new role within the Town of Carnduff. We look forward to working with the interested and successful individual as we develop this position.

#### **Responsibilities to include:**

- Act and perform all animal control duties under the Animal Control Bylaw No. 472-15. (To view this bylaw, visit <a href="www.carnduff.ca/municipal-services/bylaws">www.carnduff.ca/municipal-services/bylaws</a> or stop by the Administration Office to obtain a copy.)
- Issuing of tickets to those found in contravention of the Animal Control Bylaw.
- Provide all necessary equipment to complete the job.
- Provide own liability insurance.

Interested persons are asked to submit a letter indicating their interest in the position. Please include past experience and how you would foresee the position working. Preference will be given to those exhibiting past or similar experience. Applicants must also include expected compensation.
