#### **NUISANCE PROPERTY**

## DUTCH ELM DISEASE SURVEY

Livingtree Environmental will be in the community this summer to complete a DED (Dutch Elm Disease) survey of the trees in our community.

We would like to remind residents if it is found you have a tree test positive for DED it is the property owners' responsibility to safely remove the tree. It is also <u>ILLEGAL</u> to transport, store or buy elm firewood. If elm firewood is found on your property you will be required to remove it immediately.

Based on Provincial Regulations, you

**CANNOT** prune elm trees between April 1st and August 31st.
