LINE PAINTING

Every summer, our public works crew freshens up the many parking lines, no parking curbs and crosswalks around town with a new coat of paint. You may have noticed some have been completed and some have not. Our crew is waiting on more paint, which is a specialty asphalt paint, and will then complete the rest around town!

SAFE RESTART GRANT

The Town of Carnduff received funding from the Government of Canada Government and Saskatchewan under the Safe Restart Program. This funding is to assist communities in dealing with the impacts of COVID-19. The Town of Carnduff has already disbursed a large portion of the funding to local facilities. We would now like to open the remaining funding to organizations and facilities within the community impacted by COVD-19 throughout the past year and a half. The remaining value of funds available for distribution is \$25,560. An application can be picked up at the Town Office or call us at 306-482-3300 and we can email one out to you. Application deadline is September 3, 2021.

PROPERTY TAX DISCOUNT PERIOD

We would like to remind residents its not too late to receive a discount on your property taxes. Any amount of property tax you pay by August 31st



will receive a 4% discount on the municipal portion of the taxes!

Did you also know you are welcome to make payments throughout the year towards your property taxes. We have many residents who make a monthly or bi-weekly payment towards their taxes instead of paying them all at once!

All 2021 taxes are due December 31, 2021. There is a 10% penalty applied to any unpaid taxes after December 31st.

NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

The Town of Carnduff and R.M. of Mount Pleasant No. 2 use Everbridge as our emergency notification system.

The Town also uses this system to notify residents of important information that may affect them. The types of notices we send through this system include notifications about:

- Water shut-offs
- Precautionary Drinking Water Advisories
- Street Closures
- Fire Bans

DID YOU KNOW.....

When a Precuationary Drinking Water Advisory is issued, the Town must notify every resident affected by the advisory. If you DO NOT confirm receipt of the message we send out advising of this, we are required to post the notice on your door. Delivering notices door to door takes time and can delay the water being turned back on!


