All proceeds from the sale of these signs will be put towards the "A Walk to Remember" project.

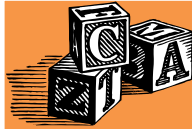

DUTCH ELM DISEASE SURVEY

Livingtree Environmental will be in the community this summer to complete a DED (Dutch Elm Disease) survey of the trees in our community.

We would like to remind residents if it is found you have a tree test positive for DED it is the property owners' responsibility to safely remove the tree. It is also **ILLEGAL** to transport, store or buy elm firewood. If elm firewood is found on your property you will be required to remove it immediately.

Based on Provincial Regulations, you **CANNOT** prune elm trees between April 1st and August 31st.

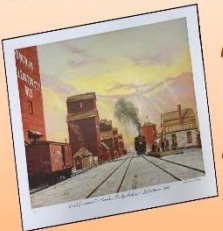

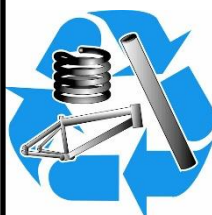
