## DUTCH ELM TREES

Livingtree Environmental completed a community survey in July of the elm trees in Carnduff. There have been 20 trees identified as diseased in the community. The Administration Office and Public Works Foreman will be working with property owners to ensure diseased trees are disposed

of. If you are a property owner with a diseased tree which were marked by red spray paint or flagging tape, you will receive a letter with more information in September.

We would like to remind residents it is **ILLEGAL** to transport, store or buy elm firewood.

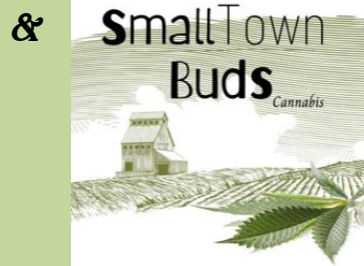
