Confirm	168/22	EXNER: That the agenda, as prepared and submitted to council, for the August 11th, 2022 meeting be hereby confirmed. CARRIED.
Minutes	169/22	PURVES: That the minutes from the regular meeting held on July 12 <sup>th</sup> , 2022 be hereby approved. <b>CARRIED.</b>
Ambulance Shed Rental Agreement	170/22	UNFINISHED BUSINESS: WALL: That Council hereby enters into a commercial space lease agreement with Saskatchewan Health Authority for the rental of a portion of the building to store the ambulance. The agreement shall be from September 1st, 2022 to August 31st, 2023. CARRIED.
Seasonal Hire	171/22	NEW BUSINESS: PURVES: That Council hereby hires Aslan Dobbyn and Bri Redpath as seasonal employees, as per the Staffing Committee's decisions. Aslan and Bri shall commence work on July 19 <sup>th</sup> , 2022 and be paid \$15.00 per hour. CARRIED.
Wage Increase	172/22	PIRIE: That Council hereby grants Gordon Hamilton a \$4.00 per hour wage increase, effective the pay period beginning August 20th, 2022. CARRIED.
UMAAS Workshop	173/22	EXNER: That Council hereby authorizes Annette Brown and Tara Beck to attend the UMAAS Community Planning Workshop on October 25th, 2022 in Weyburn. Further all costs associated will be paid by the Town of Carnduff. CARRIED.
2022 Basal Spraying	174/22	PURVES: That Council hereby accepts John Scobie's quote for basal spraying the elm trees within the Town of Carnduff. Further, the quote is for spraying 2,500 trees at a cost of \$1.20 per tree plus \$125 travel time. CARRIED.

Columbarium Cement Pad	180/22	EXNER: That Council hereby authorizes Sunset Concrete Construction to pour a cement pad for another additional columbarium at the Carnduff Cemetery, at a cost of \$5.000.00 plus taxes. Further, plans are to purchase the columbarium in 2023. Also, Council authorizes Sunset Concrete Construction to prepare and pour a headstone base pad at the cemetery for a cost of \$7,000.00 plus taxes. All funds will be taken from the Cemetery Reserve. CARRIED.
Outdoor Memorial Pad	181/22	POWELL: That Council proceeds with a 20' x 32' cement pad extension at the Outdoor Memorial Service Area in the Carnduff Cemetery, estimated cost of \$13,400.00 plus taxes. Further, the funds to complete this project shall be taken from a donation given by Gerry Curle. <b>CARRIED.</b>
