INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT UPDATES

In follow-up to the *Infrastructure Update Fall 2021* newsletter we would like to take a moment to update residents on the status of our large infrastructure projects.

Lagoon, Force main & Pumping Stations

As stated in the last update, the lagoon has been complete for sometime. Work on the pumping stations have also been substantially complete for sometime. The holdup at the time was the last portion of the force main that runs from the new pumping station #1 (on 4th Street East) to the new lagoon that runs under the rail tracks. We are excited to announce this portion was completed in April. In May we were able to bring the new pumping station online and we can officially say sewer is now pumping to the new lagoon.

There are a few final details to finish up at pumping station #1. Now work is being completed to pull components from the old pumping station to move to the new pumping station #2 such as pumps and the generator. Following the completion of this work, pumping station #2 will be brought online bringing that project to a close.



Bio Filters

Work continues at the water plant. The bio filters have been installed in

the building. All the mechanical and electrical is currently being completed to get these new filters online. We anticipate the new system being brought online by October pending supply chain dates. Full completion to the work at the water plant is anticipated to be complete next year which includes the installation of a new generator.

Raw Water Supply

The new raw water supply line was completed last fall. The line has been installed and will be tied into the new bio filter system and brought online at the same time as the filters are commissioned.

2nd Water Main

The installation of this line was completed in April. It will be commissioned and brought online in the very near future. This line brings a second supply line to all services on the south side of the rail line.

REC REPORT

The ball diamonds have been a hot spot for the community watching all the fantastic ball that's been happening here. Minor Ball finally got rolling after a couple weeks of weather delays. The Sr. Astros league play has started as well as the Sr. Cosmos after a couple of years off for them. Pool preparation is underway, stay tuned for our opening date! Swimming lessons will be held July 4-8, July 18-22 and



August 15-19. Registrations are still being accepted through our online form found on the Carnduff Swimming Pool Facebook page.

The golf course has been a popular place once the snow and rain finally cleared. The grounds committee has done a fantastic job of getting everything ready, the extra moisture sure helped green everything up out there. June starts with 3 tournaments, June 3rd is a fundraiser 4-person scramble for Jason and Pam Miller, June 4th is the annual Ladies Pink-a-Prize and June 10th, 11th & 12th is host to the Annual Men's Antler Creek. 
