DUTCH ELM DISEASE (DED)

You may have noticed a few trees with red rings painted around them. These trees have been identified as diseased with dutch elm. The survey of our community was recently completed by Livingtree Environmental. We are just waiting on the final report findings. Once these are received, we will be in contact with anyone with a diseased or suspected diseased tree on their property. We do know they found less diseased trees this year than last so that is a good sign! We thank all of our residents for their support in trying to erradicate this disease and save the many healthy elm trees we still have in our community.

be done by requesting a tax certificate for a fee of \$20. Any unpaid taxes or utility accounts which are not included in the sale agreement become the responsibility of the new owner.

Carnduff had four minor baseball teams compete at various Provincial Championships in July. Congratulations to all the players, coaches and parents who participated at Championships!


ASTROS 18U TEAM
