From time to time, we are asked questions about finding property pins. Our staff are not legal surveyors so we are unable to locate someone's property pin or lines for them. Residents can try to locate their own property pins if they want which can sometimes be found using a metal detector. However, the only way to ensure you have located the proper property lines, is by hiring a legal land surveyor.

positions that need to be filled before planning for next season can start.




