CARNDUFF CEMETERY

The spring and summer months are always a busy time of year at our cemetery so felt it only fitting to highlight what our cemetery has to offer!

Did you know our cemetery has an outdoor memorial service area people are more than welcome to use to host services? In 2019 this beautiful outdoor space was completed.

The Town also offers the opportunity for individuals to support the Cemetery Bench Project. For more information on this project please contact the Town Office. A charitable donation receipt will be issued to be used for income tax purposes for a donation towards this project.

The Carnduff Cemetery has plots available for anyone interested in pre-purchasing and planning. The cost for a traditional size plot is \$500. Our cemetery also has a columbarium option with availability at \$850 per space. For more information on plots and locations please contact the Town Office.

DUTCH ELM DISEASE (DED)

It is that time of year again to take a look at the health of the elm tree population within our community. Livingtree Environmental will once again be surveying our community and testing trees showing signs of this disease.

In 2019 we became aware of an increase in DED (Dutch Elm Disease) infected trees with our community. Since then we have been working hard to identify and eliminate infected trees in order to save the large population of remaining, healthy elm trees in our community. Each year we have performed a survey to identify infected trees and worked with owners to remove and dispose of them properly in order to stop the spread. In 2021 we completed basal spraying of all elm trees within the community as a proactive approach to stopping the spread. We will continue with spraying this season.

We would like to remind residents if it is found you have a DED tree on your property, it is the property owners' responsibility to safely remove the tree(s). It is also **ILLEGAL** to transport, store or buy elm firewood. If elm firewood is found on your property you will be required to remove it immediately.

Provincial regulations state you **CANNOT** prune elm trees between April 1st and August 31st each year. You **CAN** dispose of an entire elm tree during this time frame.

We thank our residents for working with us to stop the spread of this disease. By working together we can save the many beautiful elm trees in our community.

NUISANCE PROPERTY

What does nuisance mean? The definition of a nuisance in bylaw #374-05 states it means a condition of property, or a thing, or an activity, that adversely affects or may adversely affect:

- The safety, health, or welfare of people in the neighborhood;
- The people's use and enjoyment of their property; or
