BYLAW 2023-07

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CARNDUFF IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO ESTABLISH A LIMIT ON CASH COLLECTIONS.

The Council of the Town of Carnduff in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "Designated Officer" shall mean
 - The person appointed as the Administrator of the Municipality; or
 - ii. The person who has been delegated authority to collect and deposit cash receipts belonging to the municipality;
 - b) "Council" means the Council of the Town of Carnduff;
 - c) "Municipality" means the Town of Carnduff.
- 2. The designated officer shall deposit in the name of the Town of Carnduff, in a financial institution designated by Council, all moneys collected and receipted when they have accumulated to the amount of \$100,000.00.
- 3. Pursuant to Section 2, if the cash exceeds \$5,000.00 the designated officer shall deposit the money within one business day.
- 4. At the discretion of the designated officer, deposits may be made more frequently but, in any case, not less than once a week.
- 5. That Bylaw No. 438-13 is hereby repealed.
