


BYLAW 2023-07

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CARNDUFF IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO ESTABLISH A LIMIT ON CASH COLLECTIONS.


The Council of the Town of Carnduff in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "Designated Officer" shall mean
 - i. The person appointed as the Administrator of the Municipality; or
 - ii. The person who has been delegated authority to collect and deposit cash receipts belonging to the municipality;
 - b) "Council" means the Council of the Town of Carnduff;
 - c) "Municipality" means the Town of Carnduff.
2. The designated officer shall deposit in the name of the Town of Carnduff, in a financial institution designated by Council, all moneys collected and receipted when they have accumulated to the amount of \$100,000.00.
3. Pursuant to Section 2, if the cash exceeds \$5,000.00 the designated officer shall deposit the money within one business day.
4. At the discretion of the designated officer, deposits may be made more frequently but, in any case, not less than once a week.
5. That Bylaw No. 438-13 is hereby repealed.
