BYLAW 2023-08

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CARNDUFF IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES.

INTERPRETATIONS

Interpretations for this bylaw are from Section 2 of All Terrain Vehicles Act.

The Council of the Town of Carnduff in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. As per Section 11 of the All Terrains Vehicles Act, no person shall be allowed to operate an all terrain vehicle within the town limits of the Town of Carnduff unless a permit is made to and approved by Town of Carnduff Council.
- 2. Further to Section 1, and as per Section 9 of the All Terrains Vehicle Act, persons are permitted to operate an all terrain vehicle within the town limits if it is for the sole purpose of taking the most direct route leaving or entering the Town of Carnduff limits.
- 3. This bylaw shall come into force on the day it is finally passed by the council of the Town of Carnduff.
- 4. Any person or persons who is in contravention of this bylaw shall be subject to the penalties as set out in the General Penalty Bylaw.
- 5. That Bylaw No. 329/98 is hereby repealed.
