GOING ON HOLIDAYS?

Do you have a holiday planned where you will be away from your home or property for more than a day or two? We would like to share with you one tip that just may save you time, money and a big headache! If leaving for any length of time, we recommend you shut your water off inside your property prior to leaving.

Each property with a water service should have a shut-off valve located near the water meter. Simply turn this valve off while away. If a line was to happen to spring a leak or the power



was out for any length of time it could cause frozen lines. If your water wasn't shut-off

you could return to a big mess and hefty water bill which no one wants!

PET LICENSES

Near the end of 2022 a new Animal Control Bylaw was passed. Under the new by-law, all dogs and cats over the age of 3 months are to be licensed in the Town of Carnduff. All licenses are now for the lifetime of the animal and at a cost of \$50. To get your license, simply stop by the Town office or you can email us your information and make payment online through bill

payments or etransfer to <u>info@carnduff.ca</u>



please email us the following information regarding your pet to info@carnduff.ca:

- Specify if a cat or dog
- Pet's name
- Pet's age
- Is the pet up to date on immunizations?
- Is the pet spayed or neutered?
- Brief description
- Updated picture of your pet

Once we receive all of the information and payment, we will forward an identification tag to you.


