2023 PROPERTY TAXES

2023 Tax Summary

Property taxes for 2023 have now been levied. If you haven't received yours yet, please watch your mail box. They were mailed on May 29th.

As you will see in the brochure included with your tax notice, there was a slight increase to base tax for 2023 for land and improvements of \$73.00 per property. The mill rate staved the same.

Discount Period

Once again, we are offering a tiered discount on the municipal portion of your property taxes.

If you make payment by June 30th you will receive a discount of 6% on the municipal portion. Payments made by July 31st will receive a 5% discount on the municipal portion. Any payments received by August 31st will receive a 4% discount on the municipal portion. Even if you aren't able to pay in full, you will receive the discount on any portion you do pay!

Payments

Tax payments can be made in the office, online banking through the Credit Union or Bank of Montreal or by e-transfer. If you are paying by etransfer, please send to info@carnduff.ca

You are also welcome to make monthly or weekly payments towards your taxes. We have many residents who do this!
