### 2023 PROPERTY TAXES

#### 2023 Tax Summary

Property taxes for 2023 have now been levied. If you haven't received yours yet, please watch your mail box. They were mailed on May 29<sup>th</sup>.

As you will see in the brochure included with your tax notice, there was a slight increase to base tax for 2023 for land and improvements of \$73.00 per property. The mill rate stayed the same.

#### Discount Period

Once again, we are offering a tiered discount on the municipal portion of your property taxes.

If you make payment by June 30<sup>th</sup> you will receive a discount of 6% on the municipal portion. Payments made by July 31<sup>st</sup> will receive a 5% discount on the municipal portion. Any payments received by August 31<sup>st</sup> will receive a 4% discount on the municipal portion. Even if you aren't able to pay in full, you will receive the discount on any portion you do pay!

#### Payments

Tax payments can be made in the office, online banking through the Credit Union or Bank of Montreal or by e-transfer. If you are paying by e-transfer, please send to [info@carnduff.ca](mailto:info@carnduff.ca)

You are also welcome to make monthly or weekly payments towards your taxes. We have many residents who do this!

### GRASS CUTTING

Sunshine and rain sure has made for green grass and grass that is growing quickly! We would like to remind residents when cutting their lawns to

ensure they are not blowing grass clippings onto the street. The reason we ask people not to do this is because it causes issues with our drainage system. Clippings left on the street make their way down the curb and clog the drainage at the end of the streets.

For those that collect their grass, it can be disposed of at no charge at the landfill during regular operating hours.

### CAMPER PARKING

Camping season is upon us! Just a friendly reminder to please refrain from parking your camper on the street for more than 24 hours. We appreciate your cooperation on this matter.

### ANIMAL FECES

Unfortunately, we have noticed an increase in animal feces from dogs, cats and horses on our roadways and public spaces. The only place your animal is able to do their business without cleaning it up is on your own personal property. If you have a pet or animal decide to take care of their business while you are out and about you are required to clean-up after it. Public garbage bins to dispose of baggies can be found on Broadway Street.

### SASKENERGY INSPECTIONS

Between May 31<sup>st</sup> and June 20<sup>th</sup>, inspections of the gas line systems in our community will be completed. These inspections are conducted by SaskEnergy or a qualified Field Representative contracted by SaskEnergy. Field Representative will wear hi-visibility clothing, travel in marked vehicles and will carry identification indicating they work for or on behalf of SaskEnergy.

As always, a huge shout out to all our community volunteers and employees that make our programs and facilities possible!

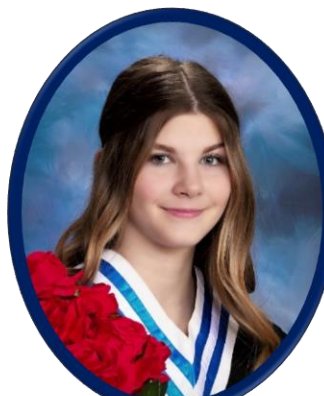

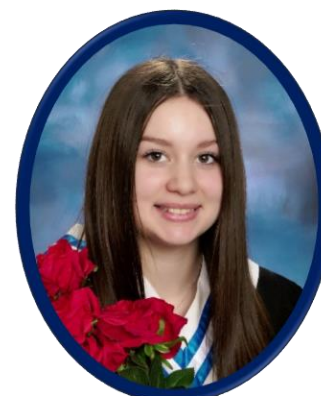
