## WATER

We hope that you are enjoying the upgraded water! It appears it is making its through the distribution system at a pretty good rate. Hydrants will be flushed on Tuesday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> which will help to get the water moving in any lines that do not have much demand.

If you have questions about the new water, we urge you to contact the office and we will do our best to answer them or find an answer for you!

Once work has fully completed, we do plan to have an open house at the plant for residents to come and check it out and see how it works.

## RECYCLING

There are some additional recycling options for residents that you may have noticed advertised in the community.

### **Household Batteries**

We now accept household batteries to be recycled at the Town Office. We



are working with call2recycle to offer this program. Items accepted include rechargeable and single-use batteries

weighing 5kg or less each. This includes alkaline, lithium primary, lithium ion, nickel cadmium, small sealed lead acid, nickel metal hydride and nickel zin. No wet-cell, damaged or defective batteries are accepted.

Automotive & Agricultural Batteries The local Lions club is participating in the *Lions Environmental Cleanup Used Battery Collection*. Effective immediately automotive and agricultural batteries can be dropped off for recycling at the R.M. of Mount Pleasant No. 2 shop. The Town Office has been working with Recycle My Electronics to start accepting cell phones, charges, cords, earbuds and earphones to be recycled. We hope to roll this option out for residents in October so please stay funed!


