SNOW REMOVAL

When it comes to snow removal, our public works crew tries hard to clear snow as soon as they are able and as efficiently as possible. A couple of things that can be done to help our crew with this include:

- Removing parked vehicles from the street (if they are parked on the street there is a chance they may get blocked in)
- Removing garbage and recycling cans as soon as you are able

Emergency routes will always be the first priority followed by main thoroughways and then residential streets.

From time to time, you may notice a snow ridge left at the end of your driveway. Our crew tries hard to avoid this however there are situations when it does happen. If you have a large driveway or multiple driveways beside each other, snow can sometimes be too heavy for the wing to pull the entire width thus leaving a ridge.

We would also like to remind everyone that snow from your property is to stay on your property. It should not be pushed to boulevards or ditches. Thank you for your cooperation on this!

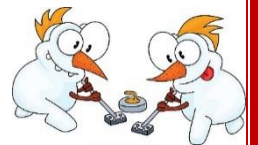
