### **PROPERTY TAXES**

A little reminder that December 31<sup>st</sup> is the deadline to pay property taxes to avoid any penalties. Any property taxes not paid by the end of the year will have a 10% interest charge on January 1<sup>st</sup>.

If you are making payment online, be sure to give yourself a few days to ensure the payment processes as it can sometimes take a few days to get to us!

How can you pay? We accept debit, cash and cheque in office. Through online banking with the BMO or Credit Union you can make payment through their respective bill payments. We also accept e-transfer to info@carnduff.ca

Also remember for next year, you can make monthly payment towards your taxes if you wish! We have many people who do this!

## PRECAUTIONARY DRINKING WATER ADVISORIES


As many people are aware, we have recently been experiencing a higher number of water leaks than normal, which has caused some water disruptions. We do our best to notify residents prior to it being shut-off however we are not always able to do this, it all depends on the dig and how it goes as things happen unexpectedly. In some instances, if the water is off for a specific period of time, there is a requirement for that portion of the town to be put on a Precautionary

Drinking Water Advisory. In these instances, we are required to notify every resident this will affect. This has to be completed before the water can be turned back on. We use our Voyent Alert system as our first step. It is *SO* important to ensure you confirm receipt of these

messages when they are sent. If you do not confirm receipt of the message, we then have to deliver a notice to your residence, this takes time and can sometimes prolong the amount of time your water is off.
