SGI GRANT

In 2023 the Town of Carnduff was successful in our application to the *Provincial Traffic Safety Fund Grant Program* offered in partnership through SGI and the Provincial Government. We would like to thank the Government of Saskatchewan for approving our application for funding for \$10,809.00 to purchase 3 speed radar signs. These signs have been permanently mounted on Railway Avenue and two on the Super Grid road. We know these signs will help to make the roads safer for both pedestrian and vehicle traffic!

that can be found on the Town of Carnduff website under Rec Schedules

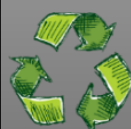
