In 2023 the Town of Carnduff was successful in our application to the Provincial Traffic Safety Fund Grant Program offered partnership through SGI and the Provincial Government. We would like to thank the Government of Saskatchewan for approving our application for funding \$10,809.00 to purchase 3 speed radar signs.
