LAGOON PROGRESS UPDATE

The contract for Stage 2, which is the completion of the pumping stations, has been awarded to Con-Tech General Contractors Ltd.



They are to begin mobilizing in April and will begin at that time. As stated in the

previous newsletter, a new pumping station is being built near the existing one and also one being added near our existing lagoon.

OUTDOOR MEMORIAL SERVICE AREA

In late November we mailed information to the local community regarding an Outdoor Memorial Service Area which has been started. This project started following receipt of donation money from a local resident. The space is being created at the Carnduff Cemetery.



It will be available to be used for graveside services or a place of reflection. To date the concrete pad has been poured, some trees planted and a couple of memorial benches purchased.
