

BYLAW 447-13

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH THE FEES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR SIGNS TO BE ERECTED IN THE TOWN OF CARNDUFF SIGNING CORRIDOR

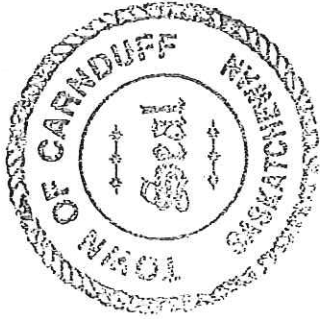
The Council of the Town of Carnduff in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "Signing Corridor Bylaw".
2. Any business or non-profit organization desiring to erect a sign in the signing corridor must submit an application to the Town of Carnduff council. The Application shall be Form "A", attached hereto and forming a part of this bylaw.
3. Applications approved by Council may be subject to further approval or further agreement with the landowner where the signing corridor is located.
4. The landowner has right of refusal for granting approval to erect the sign and to charge a fee for each sign.
5. The Town of Carnduff shall collect any fees that may be charged for utilizing the signing corridor. The fees shall then be forwarded to the landowner or to any other third party as directed by the landowner via a formal agreement.
6. In accordance with The Erection of Signs Adjacent to Provincial Highways Regulations, signs are to be located approximately 22 m from the centerline of Highway #18 and within the signing corridor boundary as established by Saskatchewan Highways and Transportation.
7. In accordance with The Erection of Signs Adjacent to Provincial Highways Regulations, the distance between each sign in the corridor shall be approximately 48 m.
8. Authorized signs permitted in the signing corridor shall ensure:
 - a) The maximum size of the sign is 48 square feet.
 - b) The signs supports are made of a minimum of 3" iron tubing or 6" x 6" treated wooden posts and shall be painted white.
 - c) The sign base is 4 feet above ground level.
 - d) Illumination of signs may not be permitted.
9. The business or non-profit organization erecting a sign shall be responsible for all costs associated with sign fabrication, erection and maintenance of the said sign.
10. Supplies associated with the erection of the sign include: 1 ½ sheets of 4' x 8' x ½" treated plywood, 5 - 2" x 6" x 8' treated lumber, 2 - 6" x 6" x 16' treated posts, 1 yard of ¾" crushed rock, white paint, screws and lag bolts, and a fee to dig the holes. The costs are subject to the current prices at a local Town of Carnduff vendor.
11. Any supplies and/or fees associated with the erection of the sign must be paid for prior to erecting the sign. Furthermore, the business or non-profit organization must complete Form "B", attached hereto and forming a part of this bylaw.
12. The Town of Carnduff Maintenance Staff may erect the sign for a fee of \$400.00. The business or non-profit organization must indicate this desire on Form "B".

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13. If the business or non-profit organization is desirous of erecting his or her own sign, the Town of Carnduff Maintenance Staff must be present when doing so.
14. Signs shall be maintained annually by the business and non-profit organization to ensure signs are kept appealing and up to date. The Town of Carnduff will remove signs not maintained adequately.
15. Bylaw No. 430-12 is hereby repealed.
