

BYLAW 464-14

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CARNDUFF TO FIX RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER AND TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED BY WAY OF SERVICE CHARGE FOR USE OF SEWER

The Council of the Town of Carnduff in the Province of Saskatchewan, pursuant to Section 23 of *The Municipalities Act*, enacts as follows:

Council of the Town of Carnduff, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known and may be cited as the "Water and Sewer Rates Bylaw" of the Town of Carnduff.
2. The charges to be paid by the water consumer whose water service has been turned on shall be those set out in Schedule "A" attached; provided, however, that the minimum shall be payable in every case whether or not any water is consumed.
4. Persons who own or occupy premises drained or that are by bylaw required to be drained into the sewer shall pay for such services a rental rate or service charge in accordance with Schedule "B" attached.
5. Accounts for water service and/or sewer service shall cover a period of three (3) successive months, and shall be rendered on or before the first day of the month next following such period. Accounts shall be paid within a period of thirty days from the date on which such accounts are rendered. If an account is not paid within the period of thirty days, the water service may be cut off. When the water service is cut off, it shall not be turned on until all arrears have been paid, together with a fee of \$25.00 to cover the expenses of turning off the water and turning it on again; provided that if it is required to turn on the water service outside the employees' regular working hours, the fee shall be \$50.00.
6. A penalty of 6 % will be added to all water and sewer accounts outstanding 120 days from the date of the next billing.
7. Bylaw 446-13 is hereby repealed.

The rates, charges, tolls or rents contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board - Local Government Committee.

SCHEDULE "A"

Water Rates

1. The following billing rates shall be charged and levied against all commercial and residential consumers within the Town of Carnduff limits from the town's waterworks where a meter has been installed:

<u>Consumption</u>	<u>Charge</u>
0 to 6,000 Imperial Gallons	\$ 155.64 Minimum
6,001 to 21,000 Imperial Gallons	\$ 10.44 per 1,000 Imp Gallons
21,001 to 36,000 Imperial Gallons	\$ 11.83 per 1,000 Imp Gallons
36,001 to 999,999 Imperial Gallons	\$ 13.23 per 1,000 Imp Gallons

2. The following billing rates shall be charged and levied against all consumers outside the Town of Carnduff limits from the town's waterworks where a meter has been installed:

<u>Consumption</u>	<u>Charge</u>
0 to 6,000 Imperial Gallons	\$ 186.77 Minimum
6,001 to 21,000 Imperial Gallons	\$ 12.53 per 1,000 Imp Gallons
21,001 to 36,000 Imperial Gallons	\$ 14.20 per 1,000 Imp Gallons
36,001 to 999,999 Imperial Gallons	\$ 15.88 per 1,000 Imp Gallons

3. Water rate for water passing through a municipal line to a temporary residential or commercial un-metered service shall be:
\$155.64 per billing or \$51.88 per month
4. Water sold from the Town's reservoir, as general water sales shall be at the following rate:
\$0.05445 per gallon

SCHEDULE "B"

Sewer Rates

Consumers who own or occupy premises drained or required by bylaw to be drained into the Town's sewage system shall pay for such a Billing Rental or service charge based on water consumption in accordance with the following:

<u>Consumption</u>	<u>Charge</u>
0 to 6,000 Imperial Gallons	\$80.31 Minimum
6,001 to 999,999 Imperial Gallons	\$6.16 per 1,000 Imp Gallons
