### **Rural Roads**

# People need to slow down on the roads and travel with more caution.

The R.M. staff is going to continue to repair and maintain roads. Rural Road update: Highway 318 closed, Lanye Douglas Road closed, working on opening Goertz Road today, road at Russell Bayliss's is closed, Curll e's road is closed, Highways is working on getting Highway 18 open to one lane traffic and will have a weight maximum. It is likely it will be another day before it is open. The road ban for 15,000 lbs is in effect until Monday with the exception of Emergency Vehicles given the approval by the Deputy Reeve.

#### Water Well & Lift Station

The water well is operating at normal capacity and has NOT been compromised. We do ask that residents of Carnduff to continue to conserve water. The lift station has exceeded its maximum capacity and thus causing extra pumping needing to be done. Please ensure that sump pumps are pumping to the street.

# **Gainsborough Route**

The route to Gainsborough will continue to be the North Route. Leaving Carnduff, you head south on the super grid and it is flagged with orange and pink flagging tape. There are maps available at the Evacuation Centre for those that would like to take a map.

## **Mental Health Services**

Mental Health Services will continue to be available at the Evacuation Centre. Please contact the centre to see what times they will be available. The number there is 306-482-3491.

#### **Evacuation Centre**

The Evacuation Centre Hours will be changing effective Saturday, July 5th. They will be 8 to 10 am and 3 to 8 pm. There will be food there for people to be able to take lunch.

#### PDAP

Next week PDAP (Provincial Disaster Assistance Program) will be on location to assist with application and information. Watch for further details on this once more information is available.

At this time monitoring of the well and lift station has been turned over to the Town and the road maintenance and recovery has been turned back over the R.M.
