SEACAN STORAGE UNITS

In July 2017, council enacted a policy regarding seacan storage containers within the Town of Carnduff. These units shall be granted in Agriculture, Commercial 2 and Industrial zones. Commercial 1 zoned areas, the units may be granted. The units will be allowed at the discretion of council in Community Service zoned areas of the community. Seacan storage units are not permitted in residential zoned areas for more than 24 hours. placement of all seacans are to be approved by the Town. Applications along with a copy of the policy are available at the Town Office or on our website under bylaws.

In 1940 the Carnduff Community Theatre Cooperative was formed and with a loan

from the Bank of Montreal and \$50 from each shareholder, equipment was purchased and set up



in its current location. This building was built in approximately 1900 and formerly operated as the Methodist Church.

Throughout the years many fundraisers and upgrades have been completed at the theatre. There have been some busy fundraising years and most recently funds were raised to move to the new digital platform in 2013 followed by new seats and lobby makeover in 2016.

The Theatre not only plays movies but looks to bring in live events. It is also used by the local archery club and The Well for church services.

The board consists of 11 board members and 5 paid staff. The latest new release movies are shown weekly on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. The theatre is most excited to be able to get back to showing live acts again soon!


