#### **SNOW REMOVAL**

It is that time of year again, any day the snow will fly! We would like to share a few friendly reminders with residents to help ensure safe and efficient snow removal by our public works staff.

Snow removal of streets always commences with emergency routes first, followed by main thorough ways, then all remaining residential streets.

Parked vehicles, garbage and

recycling bins all create a nuisance



when it comes to snow removal. They are hard to manoeuvre around, especially if it has been a large snowfall. We ask residents to please be aware of this and ensure vehicles and bins are moved in a timely manner.

From time to time you may notice a bit of a ridge is left at the end of your driveway. This can happen with large or heavy snow falls. The snow becomes too full for the blade to carry the entire distance of large or multiple driveways and is not intentionally being left.



It is also important for residents to remember any snow from private property or driveways is

to be deposited on the property the snow originates from and NOT municipal boulevards or neighbouring properties.
