- By choosing to receive your utility (water & sewer) bill by email, you save the Town \$3.40 a year in postage on the utility budget.
- Every utility billing that is processed costs the Town approximately \$435 in postage; that's \$1740 a year!
- As of the October utility billing, we had 30 accounts signed up for email billing. This was a cost savings of \$25.50. THANK YOU to those that are receiving email billing!
