INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT UPDATES

December is looking to be a busy month around the community for construction projects!

This month the construction crews are to be in town to complete the sewer force main installation under the rail line. This will complete the installation of the new force main and allow the new pumping stations and lagoon be put into service!



While the crew is in Town installing the sewer force main, they will also be installing a second water main from the corner of Spencer Street and Highway 318 across the highway and rail line, connecting at 3rd Street West. This will provide a second water service to the main portion of the community. This project is being completed under our gas tax funding. The installation of a new water service line from our well to the water treatment plant is also set to be completed in December. This new line will supply our new bio-filter system. This project is being completed with the MEEP (Municipal Economic Enhancement Program) funding the Town received.

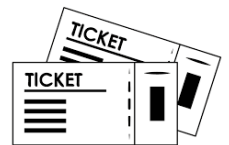

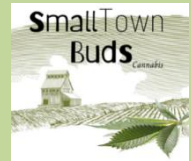
