INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT UPDATES

Last month it was looking like December would see a number of projects take place. There were some challenges we faced with a couple of projects causing some delays.

The installation of the sewer force main and second water main under the rail line was delayed. We were unable to get the equipment on site required to complete this work in December. Due to ground conditions our CP Rail permit does not allow us to start this project after December so it has been put on hold until April.

The remaining sections of the water main were completed so once the crossing under the rail line is complete, this line will be finished!

The new water service line from the wells to the water plant was completed!



This will be brought online once the new bio-filters are installed.

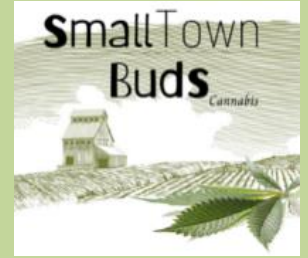

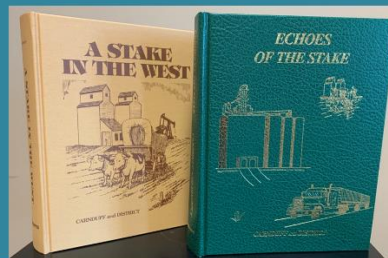
