LAGOON UPDATE

The new lagoon project is moving forward. A



qualification for contractors was completed in June for the construction of the two cells and the force main. The tender for the project has been issued and we are hopeful the contract is awarded this month with construction to begin by early fall. Design work is still being completed on the pumping stations. Once that is completed, that portion of the project will also be sent to tender.

WATER DISCONNECTION PROCESS

We would like to clarify with residents the procedure followed for water disconnection for accounts in arrears.

If your account is in arrears you will receive a note on your current water bill stating the amount in arrears and a date payment must be made by.

If payment is not made by this specified date a note will be taped to your door with the amount of payment required to cover the arrears and a final deadline.

If payment still has not been received by that date, the curb stop will be marked on your property and the water will be shut-off.

Please know that the Town is open to an aggressive payment plan to cover arrears however the office must be contacted with your intentions.

RECREATION CAMP FIRES

Just a friendly reminder of the requirements for recreational campfires (As per Bylaw #379-05)

-- Any open fire must be controlled and contained by utilizing a noncombustible container or fire barricade erected in such a manner so as not to allow the fire to spread on the ground.

- -- Any recreational open fires shall be fully extinguished at the end of any activity.
- --- Any ashes from open fires must be stored or disposed of in a non-combustible receptacle.
