LAGOON PROGRESS UPDATE

Work has commenced once again at the lagoon. Contractors have



been busy preparing the base for the liner. The liner should be

installed in the near future.

We are currently working with the engineer to confirm details to proceed with phase 2. This includes the pumping station work.

BUYER BEWARE

We would like to remind residents when buying a new home or business there are a few things they should be aware of. When a property is purchased, be sure to check on unpaid taxes and utility



accounts. This can be done by requesting a Tax Certificate for a fee of \$20. Any

unpaid taxes or utility accounts which are not included in the sale agreement become the responsibility of the new owner.

WHAT IS THE COMMISSIONAIRES ROLE?

The Town of Carnduff contracts the Commissionaires of Saskatchewan to perform bylaw enforcement for our community.

In the summer months they are hired to attend town



twice weekly to ensure bylaws are being followed. The two main bylaws that are focused on include the Nuisance Bylaw and Traffic Bylaw. Officers use their judgment when notices or warnings need to be issued. They will also tend to issues that have been received by the Town Office.

False alarms can cost the Fire Department a lot of money


throughout the year. If false alarms continue to increase, the Fire Department may have to start charging a fee for these call outs.

It is important for property owners who have alarm systems to ensure they understand how they work. With some systems, the simple task of changing a battery can set an alarm off. Some systems use a phone line to send the alarm, this will utilize the land line that is the first listed call number in an emergency which then proceeds to the next number which can be emergency services.
