

A Bylaw of the Town of Carnduff to designate routes for the transportation of dangerous goods within the Town of Carnduff.

The Council of the Town of Carnduff enacts as follows;

- (1) The streets set out in Schedule "A" to this bylaw are hereby established as dangerous goods transportation routes.
- (2) No person shall operate a vehicle transporting or designed for transporting dangerous goods in bulk other than on a dangerous goods transportation route except while such vehicle;
  - (a) is making collection or delivery, provided that the operator proceeds by the most direct route to or from the point of collection or delivery, as the case may be to or from the nearest dangerous goods transportation route;
  - (b) is proceeding to or from the business premises of the owner or operator of the vehicle, provided that the operator proceeds by the most direct route to or from the business premises, as the case may be, to or from the nearest dangerous goods transportation route.
  - (c) is proceeding to and from a garage for the purpose of repairs, servicing or refueling provided that the operator proceeds by the most direct route to or from the garage, as the case may be, to or from the nearest dangerous goods transportation route.

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on or after the approval of the Highway Traffic Board is received.

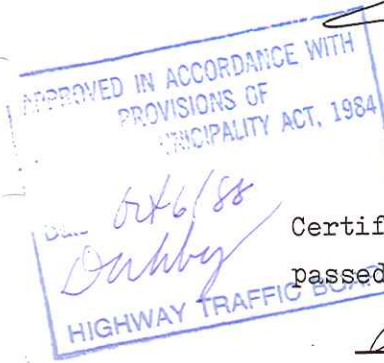

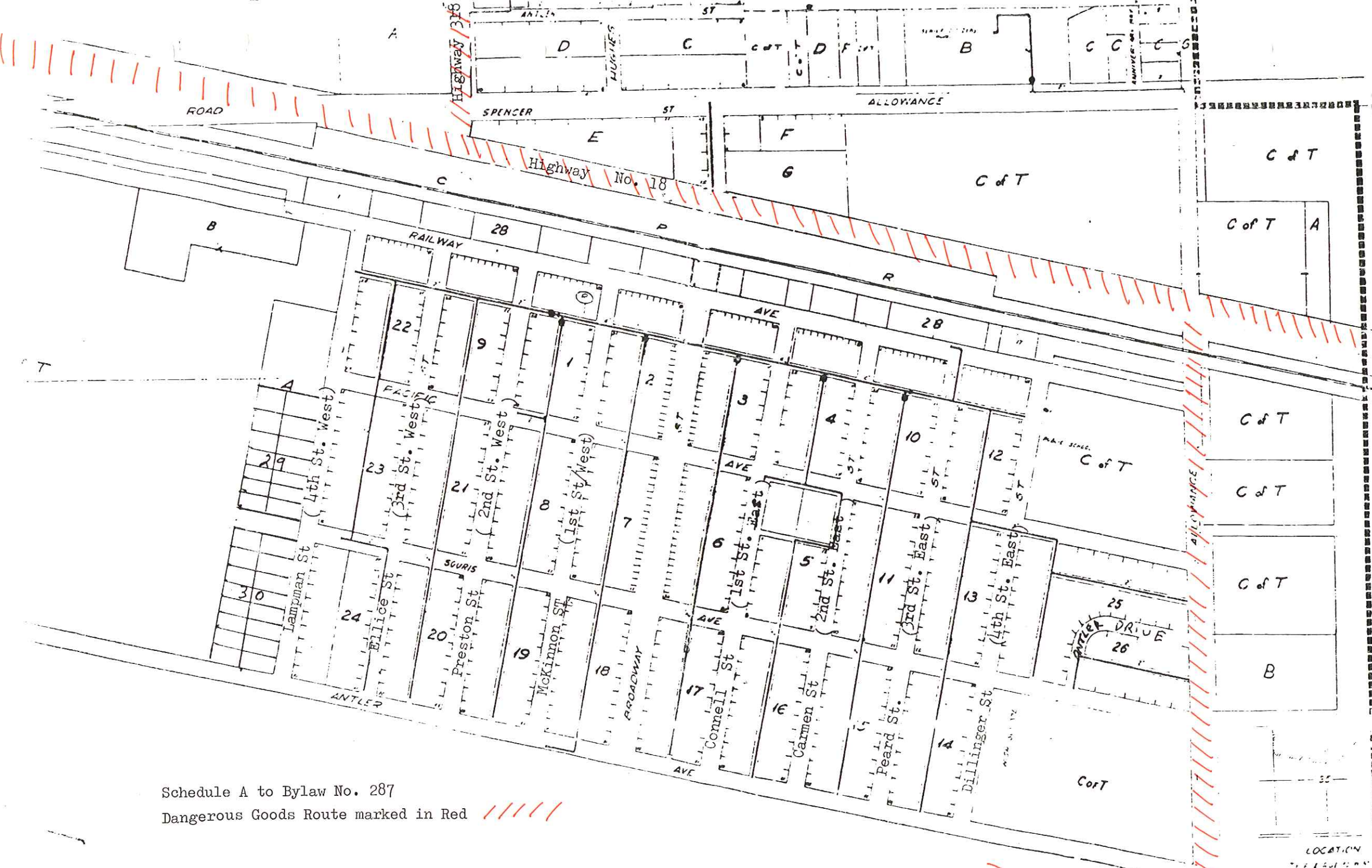
