BYLAW NO. 329/98

A Bylaw of the Town of Carnduff regulating the operation of All Terrain Vehicles.

INTERPRETRATIONS

Interpretations for this bylaw are from Section 2 of the All Terrain Vehicles Act.

The Council of the Town of Carnduff in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. As per Section 11 of the All Terrain Vehicles Act, No person shall be allowed to operate an all terrain vehicle within the Town Limits of the Municipality of Carnduff unless a permit is made to and approved by the Town of Carnduff.
2. This bylaw shall come into force on the day it is finally passed by the council of the Town of Carnduff.
3. Any person or persons who contravens Section #1 of this bylaw shall be subject to the penalties as set out in Section 32 of the All Terrain Vehicles Act.
